A lateral flow immunochromatographic assay for quantitative determination of corticosterone in saliva samples. Corticosterone, a principal glucocorticoid, is one of the most important stress biomarkers which can be detected by modern detection methods. In this study, we describe a simple, rapid and highly sensitive lateral flow immunochromatographic method for quantitative determination of corticosterone in saliva samples with a detection limit of 0.2 ng/mL, which can be used to establish a point-of-care diagnostic test for rapid identification of pigs suffering from inadequate stress during transport. The diagnostic results for the lateral flow immunochromatographic method were compared to results obtained from commercial kits. A good correlation was obtained between the manufacturer's and the present method, indicating that the method has been successfully transferred to an analytical laboratory.
